Resumption of Service Update 7-13-2021

Patrons exhibiting Covid type symptoms are asked to not enter the building. These include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

While in the building, patrons are encouraged to wear and keep in place an appropriate mask, particularly if you are unvaccinated. Patrons are also encouraged to wash hands frequently.

Patrons are required to maintain social distancing and to avoid close contact with staff and other library users. Patrons are also required to cover your coughs and sneezes.

Services currently offered include:

- Copying
- Drinking fountains
- Entrance through both north (parking lot side) and south doors
- Faxing
- Homebound delivery
- Interlibrary loan
- Issuing library cards in normal manner
- Item returns to both the outdoor and indoor book drops with no quarantine.
- Library store
- Notary
- Physical lending/borrowing (checkout limited to 25 items per card)
- Programs in person, web-based, and hybrid formats
- Printing
- Proctoring for long-distance education programs
- Public computer use (a limited number of units are available to facilitate social distancing)
- Public restrooms
- Reference/research
- Reserves
- Scanning
- Seating (expanded but still limited)
- Summer reading registration, recording and prize issuance for all ages
- Visitation limited to one hour
- Voter registration

Services not yet resumed:

- Donation of used books, discs, etc.
- Meeting room open to the public
- One-on-one classes and assistance
- Seating at full capacity
- Resumption of charging fines
- Unlimited visitation
