Like art? Come to this class to examine the intricacies of classic stories, paintings, films, and more!!

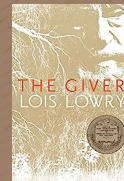

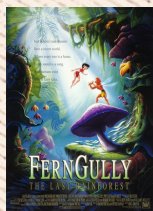

Movie Days

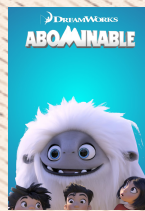
